New Zealand has a new Firearms Registry. If you're a firearms licence holder, you have until 24 June 2028 to register your firearms. However, there are activating circumstances when you're required to provide information to the Registry within a shorter time frame. 1. This form is used to apply for approval of the sale and purchase of prohibited parts by mail order or on the internet.
2. In addition, where purchasing by mail order or on the internet, the item must be delivered by the courier as agreed or specified by Police.
3. You may not take possession of any prohibited part unless you have:
 1. a current firearms or dealer licence, and
 2. a current firearms endorsement appropriate to the item being purchased.
